Junior Year

Fall Semester

Snare:

Concepts:

- Portraits in Rhythm by Anthony Cirone
- Working through some of the early solos in this book will give the student a variety of techniques to work on, and help to prepare them for the type of playing they may see in allstate auditions.

Suggested Repertoire:

-Three Dances for Solo Snare Drum by Warren Benson

- Multiple movement can be spread throughout the semester, and will provide the student with a solo to play at festivals.

Mallets:

Concepts:

- all major and minor scales with 2 mallets
- practice these in a variety of ways (thirds, octaves, etc.)

Suggested Repertoire:

Masterpieces for Marimba by Thomas McMillan

- good for applying scale knowledge
- work on musicality
- prepares for all state auditions

Timpani:

Concepts:

- introduction to stroke types and grips
- recommend American or French
- use band or orchestra pieces they are doing to demonstrate

Spring Semester

Snare:

Concepts:

- We will dig into the 26 basic rudiments including how to practice them and how they are applied.
- Start looking at some more challenging Cirone etudes.

Suggested Repertoire:

14 Modern Contest Solos for Snare Drum by John S. Pratt

- We will start looking at early solos in this book to apply rudimental concepts that we are working on.

Mallets:

Method of Movement by Leigh Stevens

- begin working on four mallet technique
- we will use this as a reference for exercises putting them in all keys
- practice with a click
- work on major and minor scales while holding four mallets

Suggested Repertoire:

- short beginner solos utilizing four mallet techniques

- includes solos
- would only have to buy one book

Snare Drum:

Concepts:

-Excerpts from the back of Modern School for Snare Drum by Morris Goldenberg

- We will work on some of the most common snare excerpts for auditions. We will have to check schools that the student is interested in for specifics.

Suggested Repertoire:

Douze Etudes (Twelve Studies) for Snare Drum by Jacques Delécluse

- This book will provide a contrasting solo with the Pratt for college auditions.

Mallets:

Concepts:

- start working on common orchestral excerpts for auditions, such as Porgy and Bess

Suggested Repertoire:

Six Suites for Cello by J.S. Bach

- exposes student to classical literature
- perfect for demonstrating technique and musicality in college audition

Timpani:

- work on orchestral excerpts from the back of the Goodman book
